How to Cite an eBook with One Author from a Database or Website

What's Needed

1. Author's last name, author's first name
2. Title of book(in Italics) : subtitle if any
3. Edition- if given
4. Name of publisher
5. Latest copyright date
6. Name of library database or website
7. If website – URL and date accessed

Examples:

From Library Database

From Website
